## School Organisation Proposal: Change of Age Range

Dear Parents, Carers, Governors, Staff and other stakeholders,

I am writing to advise you that Birmingham City Council is developing a proposal in collaboration with the school leadership team and Governing Body to make the following change to Newtown Nursery School:

- Change the lower age range of the school from 2 years 5 years to 9 months – 5 years
- Effective from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2025

Newtown Nursery School is a community school which offers 72 full-time-equivalent pupil places and was rated 'Outstanding' by Ofsted in March 2024. The school has nursery provision for 72 full-time-equivalent places.

This letter is to notify stakeholders and provide an opportunity to submit any immediate questions or comments by letter or email using the details at the bottom of this letter and no later than 7<sup>th</sup> March 2025. This stage of the process is the informal consultation known as the "pre-publication" period. After the pre-publication period, the Council intends to publish and consult on a complete statutory proposal document. We will write to you again with further details at that time.
